

**Addendum to *Kadir Has University Regulations for Graduate Education*
for Kadir Has University and Coventry University Dual-Award Programs Only**

Addendum to Article 39 (2): Period of study of the non-thesis-track Master's program

- 39.2.1 Students studying for a dual-award from Kadir Has University and Coventry University must complete the non-thesis-track taught postgraduate program within the maximum period of study of three years in order to be eligible for the dual-award.

Students who fail to complete the non-thesis-track taught postgraduate program within the maximum period of study of three years and who register to continue studies, will not be eligible for an award from Coventry University, and will register to continue studies with Kadir Has University only.

As stipulated in Article 29, the period of time granted for a suspension of studies will not be counted towards the maximum period of studies.

Addendum to Article 40 (1): Diploma for non-thesis track Master's program

- 40.1.1 Students studying for a dual-award from Kadir Has University and Coventry University will be eligible for the following interim awards from Coventry University only. A interim qualification is only conferred if students fail or withdraw from the next stage of the program i.e. students completing a postgraduate program in full will not be eligible for an interim award.

Academic Award This is not a cascade of awards	Minimum ECTS Credits to be Passed
Coventry University Postgraduate Certificate	30
Coventry University Postgraduate Diploma	60

- 40.1.2 A student who obtains 30 ECTS credits within the terms of an approved dual-award program shall be eligible for the award of Coventry University's Postgraduate Certificate.
- 40.1.3 A student who obtains 60 ECTS credits within the terms of an approved dual-award program shall be eligible for the award of Coventry University's Postgraduate Diploma.
